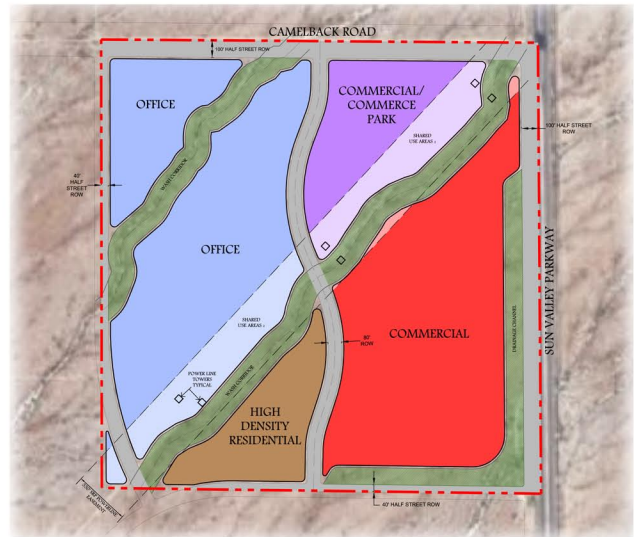


Camelback Crossing

Buckeye, Arizona

Camelback Crossing is a 156 acre mixed use master plan comprised of commercial, business park, office, and high-density residential land uses. It is part of a larger 640 acre master plan for an entire section of land in Buckeye, Arizona. The Camelback Crossing master plan includes over one million square feet of commercial/office land uses and a proposed 200+ unit multi-family residential development. Immediately adjacent to the development is a school, neighborhood park, and additional residential development, making this a true mixed use project where residents can live, work, and play.
