Centrada has been designed as an intense, multi-use destination located just south of the University of Phoenix Stadium in Glendale. The site will be arranged in three distinct residential, mixed-use entertainment and employment. Each district will possess its own unique character through the use of landscape and architectural design elements but united as a whole through uninterrupted pedestrian connections organized around streets, parks and plazas. The distinctive development of Centrada is intended to become an authentic community center.
