
Buckeye, Arizona

Douglas Ranch is a master planned community located in western Maricopa County. Designed as a self-sufficient community, the project offers a broad range of housing types, commercial services, employment centers, medical services, schools (including a community college), parks, emergency response, and plans for religious facilities.

Design guidelines place an emphasis on the preservation of the natural environment (by preserving the drainage network), the establishment of a community theme to create identity and the promotion of housing diversity.










High School District Plan
