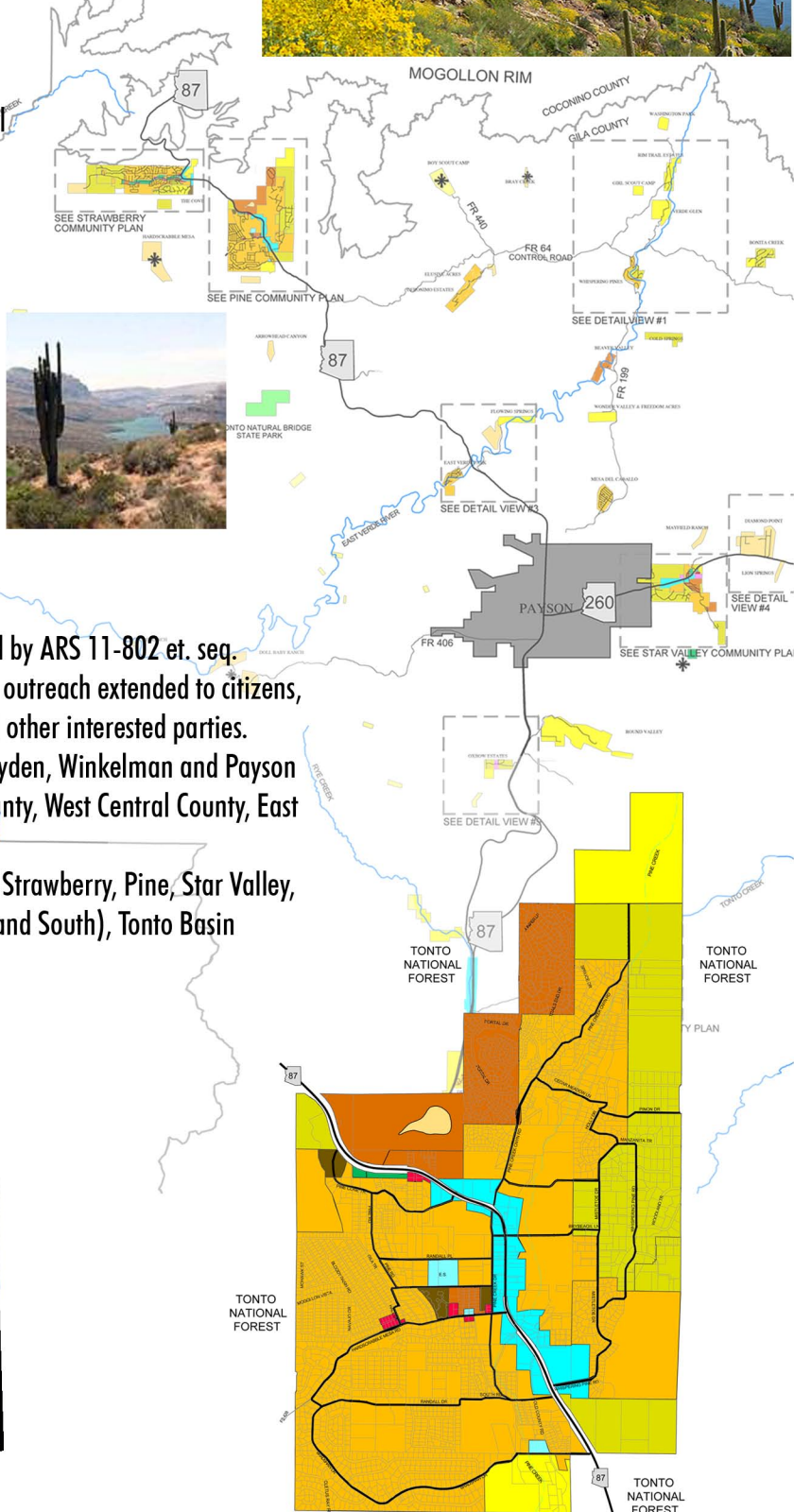


Gila County Comprehensive Master Plan

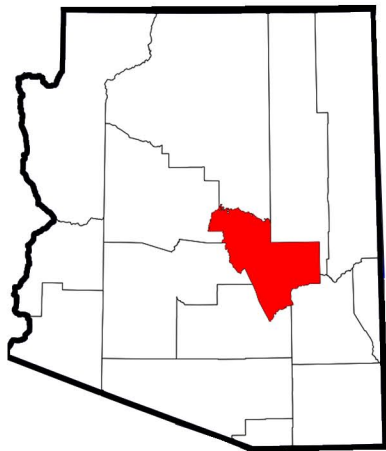
The age of the existing comprehensive plan (adopted in 1971), significant growth and development changes within the unincorporated portions of the County and new State legislation (Growing Smarter/Plus) prompted the County to retain LVA to prepare a substantial update, leading to its adoption in 2003. The document continues to guide the future growth and development within the County through 2013 and includes the following four chapters:

- Executive Summary-including intended use and plan elements
- Introduction- includes overview and physical setting
- Plan Elements-includes land use, transportation and public facilities in a standard format of existing conditions, goals, objectives and policies, plan description and implementation program.
- Administration-includes interpretation, periodic review and amendments

- 4,769 sq. mi. of land
- Provides development guidance as mandated by ARS 11-802 et. seq.
- Significant public participation program with outreach extended to citizens, property owners, governmental agencies and other interested parties.

- Area Plans: Northwest County, Northeast County, West Central County, East Central County, South County
